FVF Deck AB

Minimum Qualifications required to bid, including lateral transfers and downgrades:

- Possession of a valid United States Coast Guard Merchant Mariner's Credential (MMC) with Able-Bodied Seaman endorsement
- Possession of a valid Transportation Worker Identification Card (TWIC)
- High Speed Craft Certification
- Possession of valid Standards of Training, Certification, and Watchkeeping for Seafarers Certificate (STCW-95) or STCW certification on the MMC.
The STCW Certification must be endorsed for:
- Proficiency in the Use of Survival Craft
 - Fast Rescue Boat
 - Rating Forming Part of a Navigational Watch – Lookout Only
- Passenger RO/RO Certification including:
 - Crowd Management
 - Vessel Specific Familiarization Training
- Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) or Respectful Workplace Certification
- Basic HCT Curriculum
- Forklift Compliance HCT
- Hazmat Basic (Seagull Web Course)
- Security 101 and 201
- Valid Marine Evacuation System Certification
- Advance Firefighting Training
- Valid Driver's License
- 2016 hours experience in the deck department of the AMHS
