## Qualified Member of the Engine Department (QMED)

### U.S. Coast Guard Approved Course

Thirteen Weeks - 10 September 2012 through 3 December 2012

This course is designed for any mariner that presently meets the USCG sea service and horse power requirements of 180 days in a rating at least equal to wiper or coal passer etc 46 CFR 12.15-7 to apply for a USCG QMED rating.

Any applicant successfully completing this QMED Program and presenting this Certificate of Training at a Regional Exam Center within one year of the completion of training, will satisfy the examination requirements of 46 CFR 12.15-9 for an endorsement as Qualified Member of the Engine Department – Oiler, (QMED-Oiler) and will receive *90 days sea service credit* that can be applied to the sea service requirements for any QMED endorsement. In order to fulfill all of the QMED requirements, the applicant must also present documentation showing at least 180 days engine room sea time, and the training requirements of 46 CFR 12.15-3 (e) and Section A-111/4 and Table A-111/4 of the STCW Code. Candidates for this course must have a minimum of 10th grade reading and math level skills as verified by TABE tests administered before entry.
