Applying for the "PSC/LIFEBOATMAN" STCW Endorsements on MMC:

AMHS crewmembers obtain USCG Lifeboatman certification. This is two (2) part: 1) the National Rating "Lifeboatman" and 2) the International - STCW - Proficiency in Survival Craft (PSC) for the endorsement of "*Proficiency in survival craft and boats other than fast rescue boats (PSC)*". The USCG charges a fee for National Endorsements (Ratings/Licenses) to MMC's; STCW Endorsements are free.

- 01** *Mariners should have close to the USCG required sea service of 180 days prior to attending an USCG approved PSC/Lifeboat class. For Training Class Flyers, please visit the Internal Resources Website:*

- 02** Once you complete the PSC/Lifeboat class, submit the class certificate, Sea Time Letter and the completed CG-719B application form to your local USCG Regional Exam Center or National Maritime Center to apply for the "*PSC/Lifeboatman*" endorsements to your current MMC.



- 03** You will receive your PSC/Lifeboatman endorsements in the form of stickers that are to be inserted into your MMC booklet. When you insert your new stickers, please ensure that they are in chronological order. You may submit your document(s) to the following email address:
